- **Adult Programs:** A Medicaid program that pays the medical bills of people who have low income and cannot afford medical care.
- **Programs for children:** The Maryland Children's Health Insurance Program (MCHIP) gives full health benefits for children up to age 19, and pregnant women of any age who meet the income guidelines.
- **Medication Programs:** Senior Prescription Drug Assistance Program (SPDAP) provides financial assistance to moderate-income residents who are enrolled in an approved Medicare prescription drug plan.

Health Reform Status:

Exchange: Maryland will run its own state-based health insurance exchange.

Medicaid: The state will expand Medicaid eligibility.
