- **Programs for Children:** Dr. Dynasaur is a health insurance program for children, teens under 18 and pregnant women.
- **Additional Programs:** A family of health insurance plans offered by the State of Vermont and its partners that includes plans such as Catamount Health, Vermont Health Access Plan (VHAP), Dr. Dynasaur, Medicaid, and a number of pharmacy assistance and premium assistance programs.
